

# Rules of boilie fishing - 2016

## Rules of boilie fishing on Lake Tisza

Angler who has bought boilie fishing ticket for a year or a week shall comply with the respective provisions of the Angling Rules of Lake Tisza, and in accordance with its point 20, the regulation detailed hereinafter. The breach of this regulation means the breach of the Angling Rules of Lake Tisza and results in the withdrawal of regional ticket.

The owner of boilie fishing ticket takes note that the whole area of Lake Tisza is also a shipping area.

### 1. General provisions:

1.1. Boilie fishing is only allowed with a boilie fishing ticket valid for a year or a week.

1.2. Boilie fishing is considered to be the fishing method when the rig is deployed without throwing by using a boat, then after its deployment the angler waits for the bite on the shore or on a water facility.

1.3. The aim of boilie fishing is to catch, measure, photograph, then humanely release the peaceful fish back into the water.

1.4. On the basis of the above principle, the angler with a boilie fishing ticket shall comply with the rules of humane treatment in the case of every caught fish (see point 3).

1.5. In each case anglers shall be required to register before fishing.

1.6. Boilie fishing is possible regionally in two cases:

1.6.1. Boat fishing is allowed only in Poroszló-basin. In this case, registration data shall include the exact GPS coordinates of the boat and the planned period of stay.

1.6.2. Bank fishing is possible only on the designated boilie fishing spots. These spots can be viewed on [www.sporthorgasz.eu](http://www.sporthorgasz.eu). Here you can register, or the spots can be occupied on a first come, first served basis. However, if any angler who has a valid reservation arrives at the spot, the other one shall move over. (These spots can be used by everyone, but if an angler with a boilie fishing ticket arrives at the area, the angler who does not have boilie fishing ticket shall step aside.)

1.7. One person shall reserve only one fishing spot for the same period, and shall have not more than two reservations on the given date.

1.8. A boilie angler shall not angle with a non-boilie angler on the same fishing spot at the same time.

1.9. The period of a given reservation shall not be more than 14 days without interruption. Before angling, however, one shall register and registration has to be done on a weekly basis.

1.10. With a reserved spot and a (yearly or weekly) boilie fishing ticket the angler shall keep daily one, weekly three indigenous fish weighing less than 5 kg for consumption.

1.11. With a reserved spot and a (yearly or weekly) boilie fishing ticket the angler shall not keep indigenous fish weighing more than 5 kg even in possession of a normal regional ticket.

### 2. Rules of boilie fishing:

2.1. The angler is allowed to fish with 2 fishing rods and with one single hook per rod. Offering hair rigs and artificial bait is a compulsory principle.

2.2. Braided line shall not be used as main line but only as a hook leader. Leadcore is allowed to be used in a length not more than 1 metre.

2.3. Angling is allowed only on the designated fishing spot belonging to the reservation.

2.4. Tackles can be cast perpendicular to the shore. Diversion is allowed only within the area bordered by the designated fishing spot and without disturbing other anglers.

2.5. In the case of boat fishing, tackles can also be deployed laterally without disturbing other anglers. In this case, however, the distance between the two buoys shall not be more than 50 metres.

2.6. Each angler is allowed to use two H buoys or spar buoys which shall be illuminated from sunset to sunrise. After angling, the buoys shall be removed from the water.

2.7. Another angler shall only be in the area between the boilie fishing spot and the buoy belonging to it with the permission of the boilie angler.

2.8. Tackles can be deployed by casting from the shore, by boat or by carrying it (boilie fishing). It is prohibited to use feeding boat.

2.9. In the case of boilie fishing, the tackle is considered to be protected and guarded - if the angler has such a bite indicator system that indicates bite with sound and light - also in the following cases:

- the angler is within the range of 50 m from his tackles on the designated fishing spot.
- the angler is on the water with the purpose of exhausting, releasing or feeding the fish, or placing the tackles.

### **3. Rules of humane treatment:**

3.1. It is prohibited to take away or store any indigenous fish weighing more than 5 kg. The prohibition of storage also applies to the night period.

3.2. In accordance with the principle of humane treatment, fish shall be released back into the water immediately after photographing and measuring it.

3.3. Fish shall be on the shore only during photographing while continuously being watered. It is possible to photograph fish only in a crouching or kneeling height above a carp mattress; it is prohibited to take photos in a standing position.

3.4. In order to practice humane fishing methods it is compulsory to have and use the following tools:

- Boat. (The exhaustion of fish shall only be done by standing with the boat above the fish, it is forbidden to pull the fish to the shore!) Compulsory equipment of the boat - in addition to the compulsory accessories specified in the law - includes a carp mattress which is used by the angler to carry the fish to the shore.

- Good quality, thickly padded, waterproof and large carp mattress. (It is compulsory to use wet carp mattress to place the fish)

- Dense, min. 90x90 cm scoop-net.

- The use of sinking line is compulsory in order not to disturb boat traffic.

- Mouthwash.

3.5. It is PROHIBITED to mark or dismember the caught fish.

(The caught fish shall only be marked by the competent expert of Tisza-tavi Sporthorgász Kft. with the common fish marking method in order to receive information about the wandering and growth of the fish in the case of a subsequent catch.)

Issues not covered by the boilie fishing rules are governed by the respective angling rules of Lake Tisza, the rules it contains shall compulsorily be complied with.
